

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

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
Kit Assembly

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- Unclip and remove the trim panel above the glove box and below the A/C control. (Figure A)
- 2. Unclip and remove the shifter trim panel. (Figure B)






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
- 3. Unclip and remove the A/C control. (Figure C)
- 4. Remove (4) 10 mm bolts securing the radio. (Figure D)
- **5.** Remove the (4) Phillips screws securing the outer A/C vent trim panel to the factory radio and separate. (Figure E)




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
ISO DIN radio provision with pocket

- Secure the radio housing brackets to the radio housing with four #8 3/8" Phillips screws provided. (Figure A)
- Attach the pocket to the bracket/radio housing assembly with the four #8 3/8" Phillips screws provided. (Figure B)
- 3. Align the holes in the radio housing brackets with the holes in the ISO DIN radio and secure the brackets to the radio with the screws included with the radio. (Figure C)
- 4. Attach the outer a/c vent trim panel to the radio housing using the factory hardware. (Figure D)
- 5. Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra or AXXESS. Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the radio for proper operation.
- 6. Reassemble dash in reverse order of disassembly.





Double DIN radio provision

- Attach the outer A/C vent trim panel to the radio housing using the factory hardware. (Figure C)
 - Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra or AXXESS. Re-connect the

negative battery terminal and test the radio for proper operation.

5. Reassemble dash in reverse order of disassembly.




2. Slide the double DIN radio into the bracket/radio
